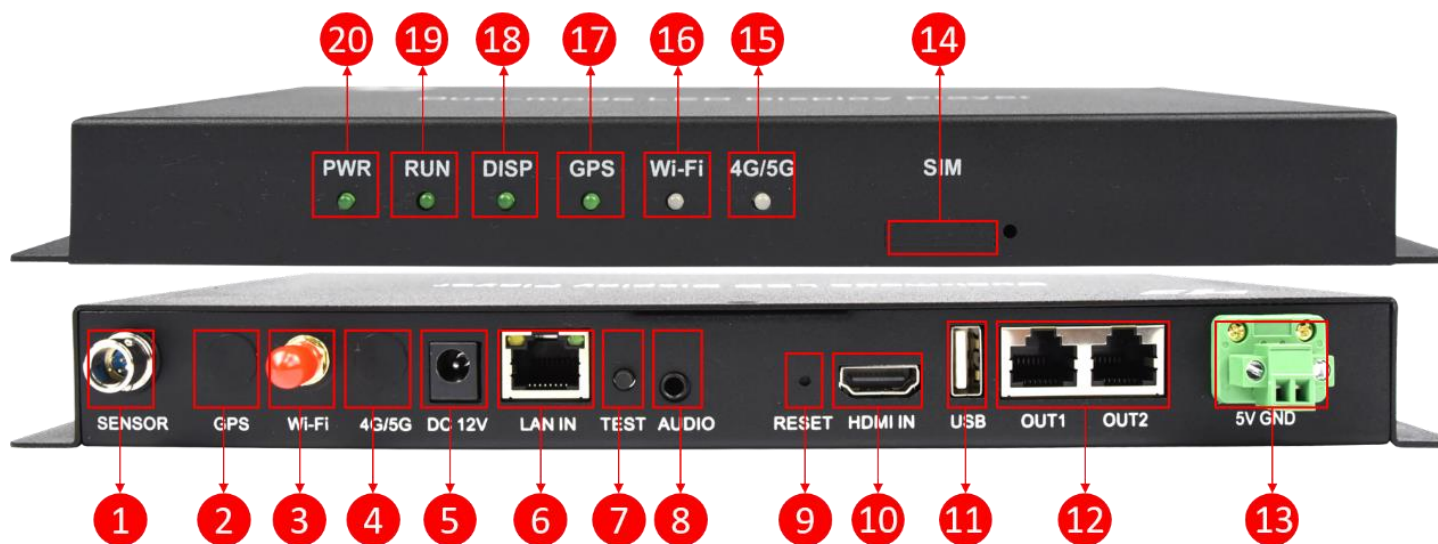

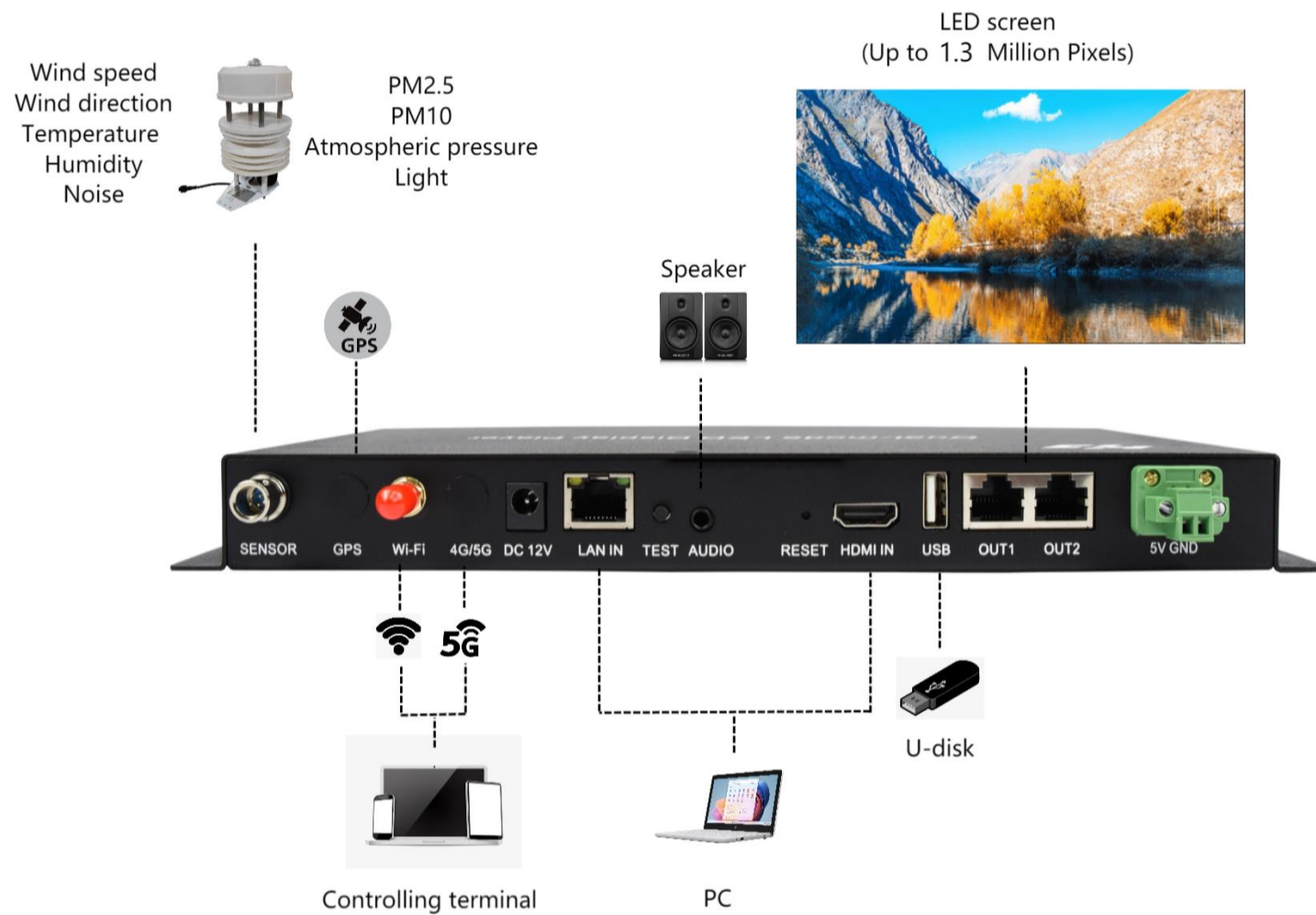


1.1 HD-A4 Appearance and interface

No.	Name	Function
1	Sensor port	For connect S108, S208 Sensor.
2	GPS port	Satellite time (optional), Fixed-point broadcasting.
3	Wi-Fi Antenna port	Connecting Wi-Fi Antenna.
4	4GAntenna port	Connecting 4G Antenna (optional).
5	Power port	Connect 12V.
6	Input LAN port	Connected to the computer or LAN.
7	Test button	For test module.
8	Audio output port	Standard two-channel stereo output.
9	Reset button	Used to restore default parameter values.
10	HDMI Input port	Video Signal Input, Connecting Computer, Set Top Box, etc.
11	USB port	Connecting USB devices, such as: U disk, mobile hard disk, etc.
12	Output Network Port	Connect to Receiving Card.
13	Power port input	Connect DC 5V power.
14	SIM card slot	Inserted with 3G/4G card for 3G/4G internet (Optional).
15	4G indicator	Normal green flashes (Optional).
16	Wi-Fi indicator	Showing the Wi-Fi working status.
17	GPS indicator	Showing the GPS working status.
18	Screen Display indicator	Showing the programs status of the display.

19	RUN running indicator	Showing the box working status.
20	Power indicator	Showing power-on status of the box.

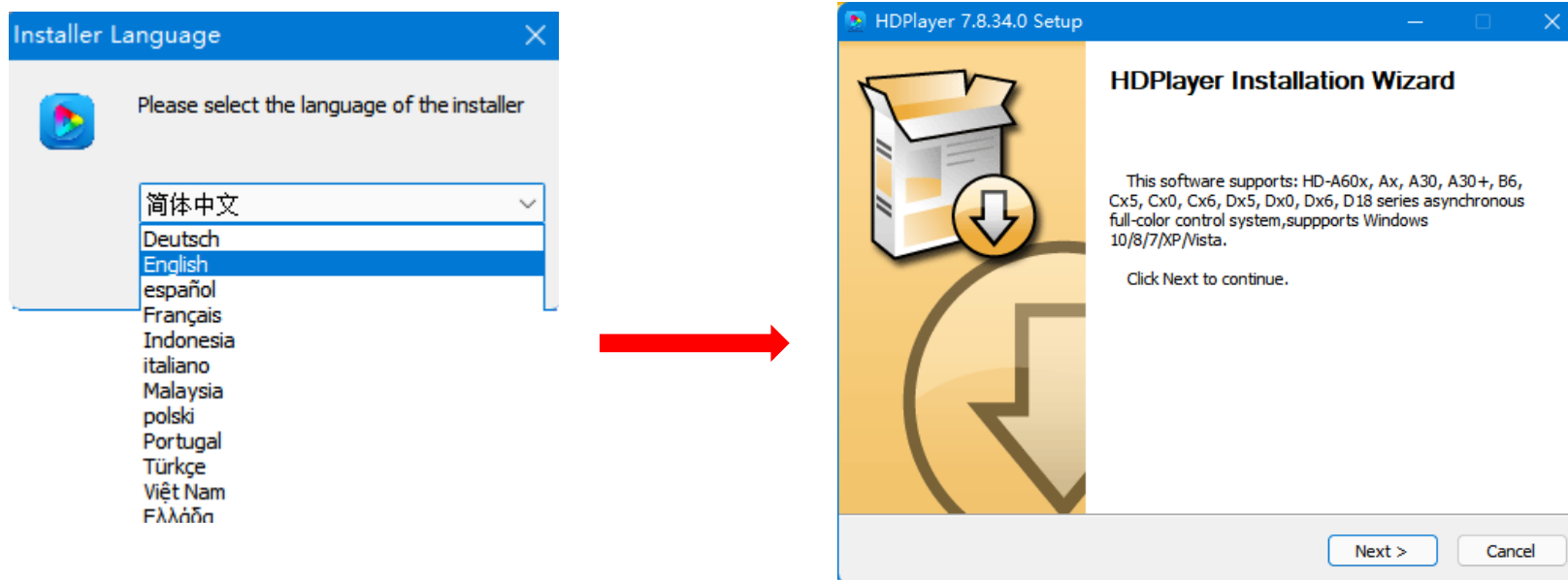

Please download the installation package of HDPlayer software from Huidu's official website www.huidu.cn, and complete the installation according to the diagrams below:

1.Run the software package,then select language for installer. Click [OK] to go on.

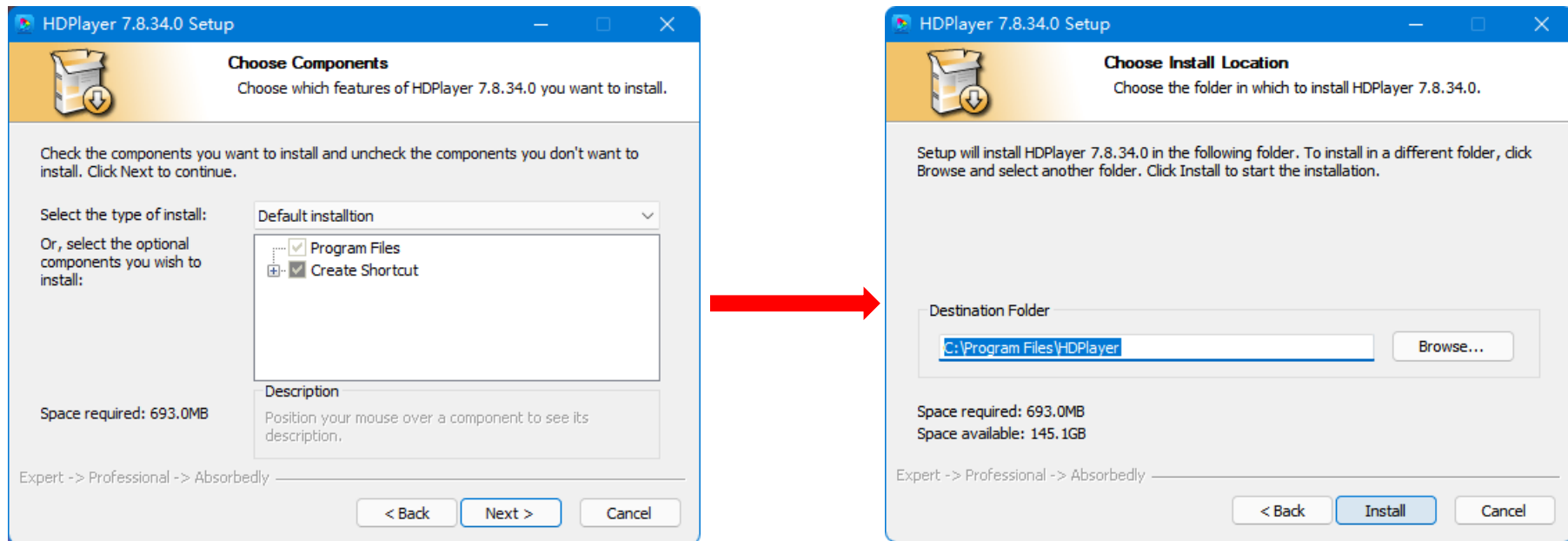


2. After selecting a language, an installation wizard like below will appear. Click [Next].

3.1 Connection

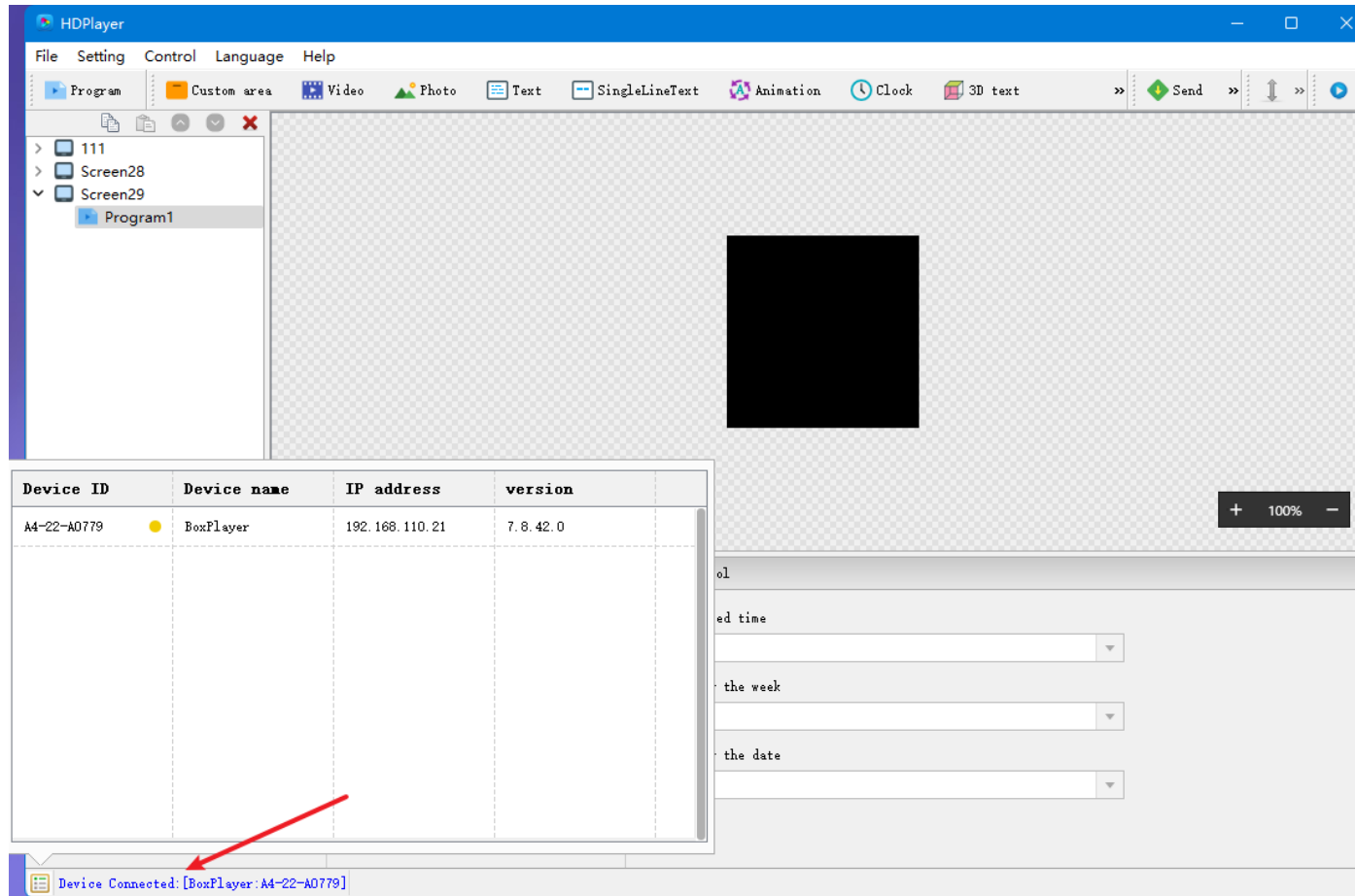
Connect the A5 to the computer by net cable or WiFi(Default password:88888888).



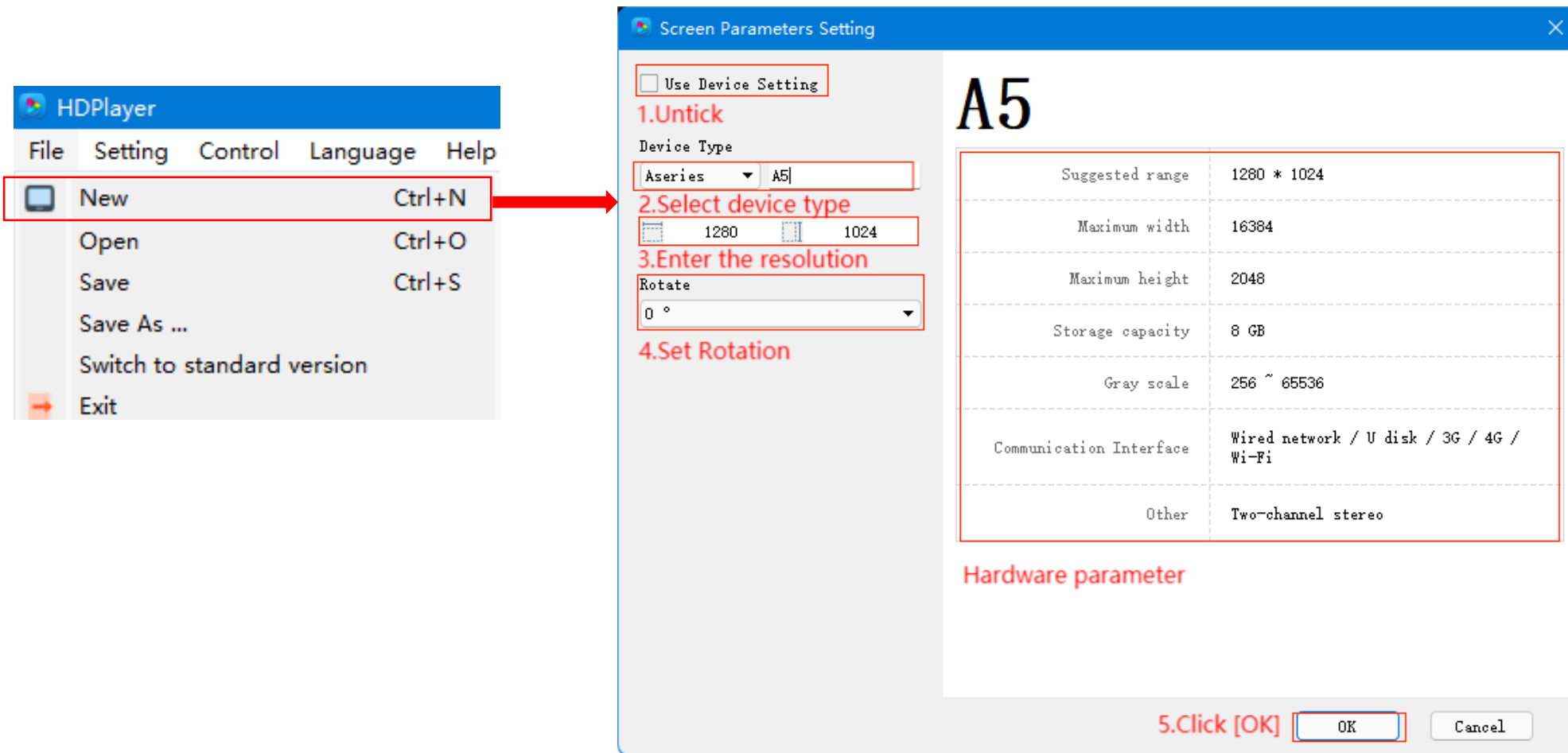
3.2 Basic Setting

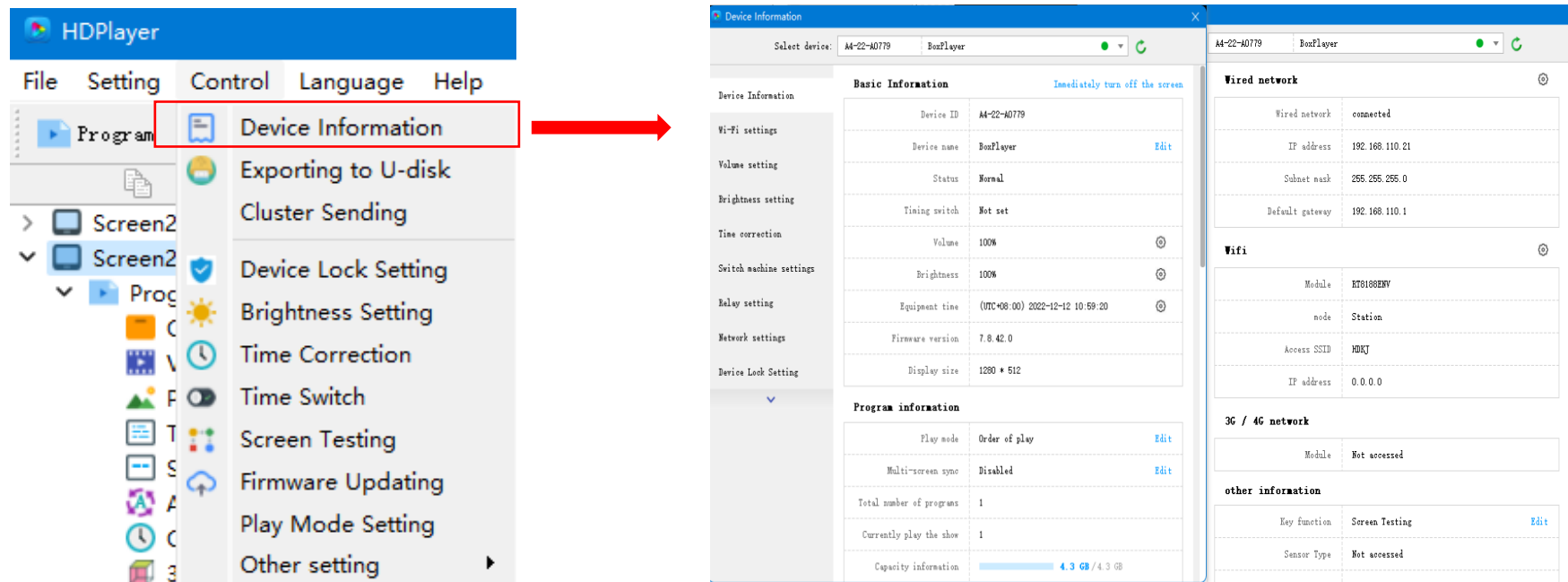
A4 is dual-mode display player.

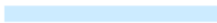

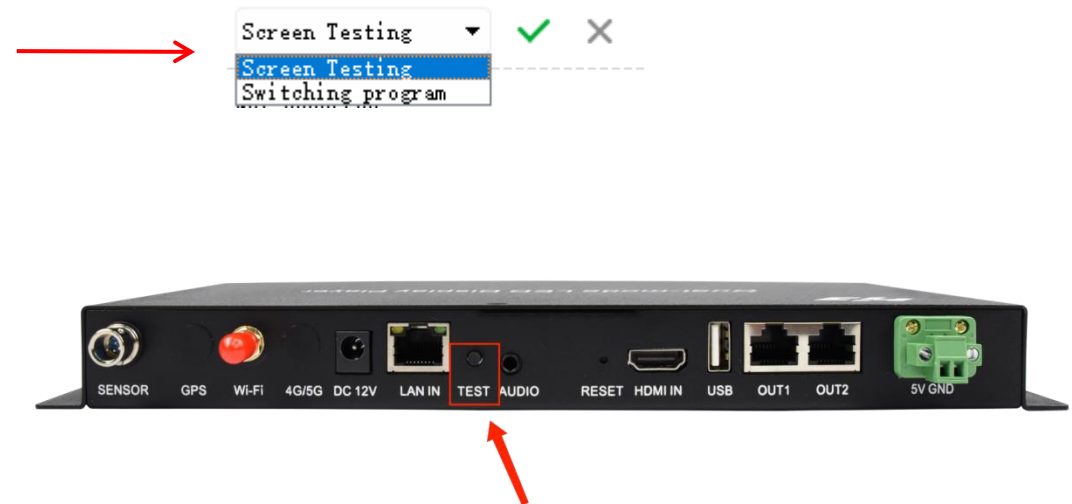

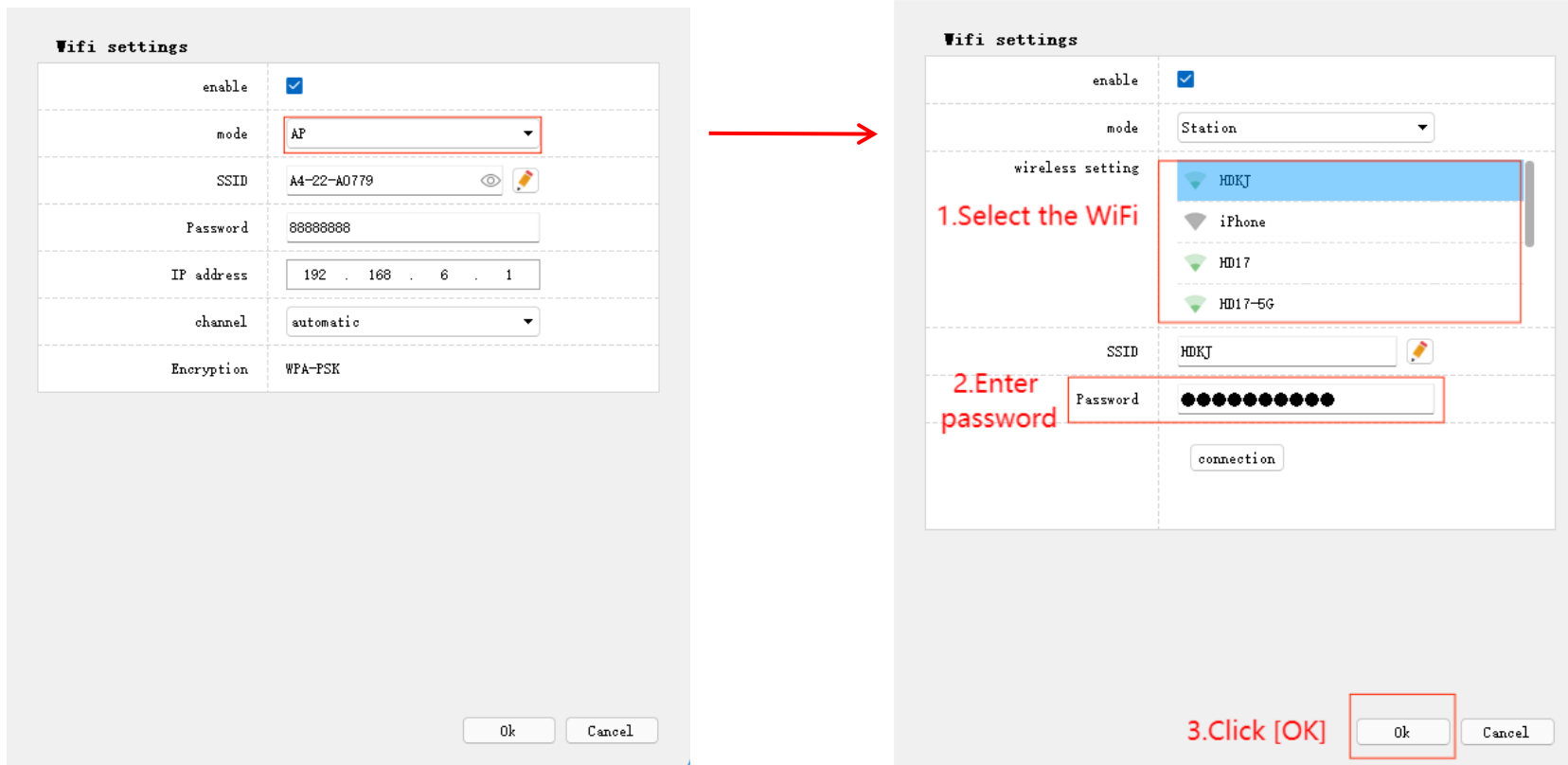

3.3.4 Brightness setting

Default mode: Set fixed brightness

Custom mode: Set the time frame for brightness

Automatic mode: A5 automatically change Brightness according to the sensor.

Sensitivity Indicates the frequency of detection.[High] means every 5 seconds;[in] mean 10;[low] mean 15.

You'd better set Brightness monitoring interval to 3400-7000.

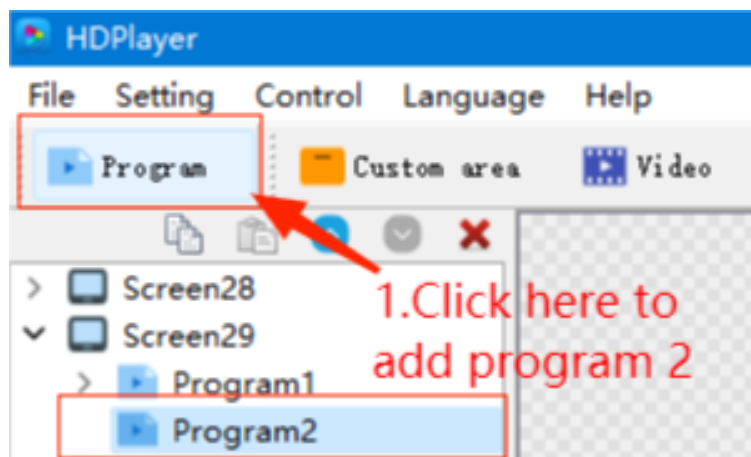

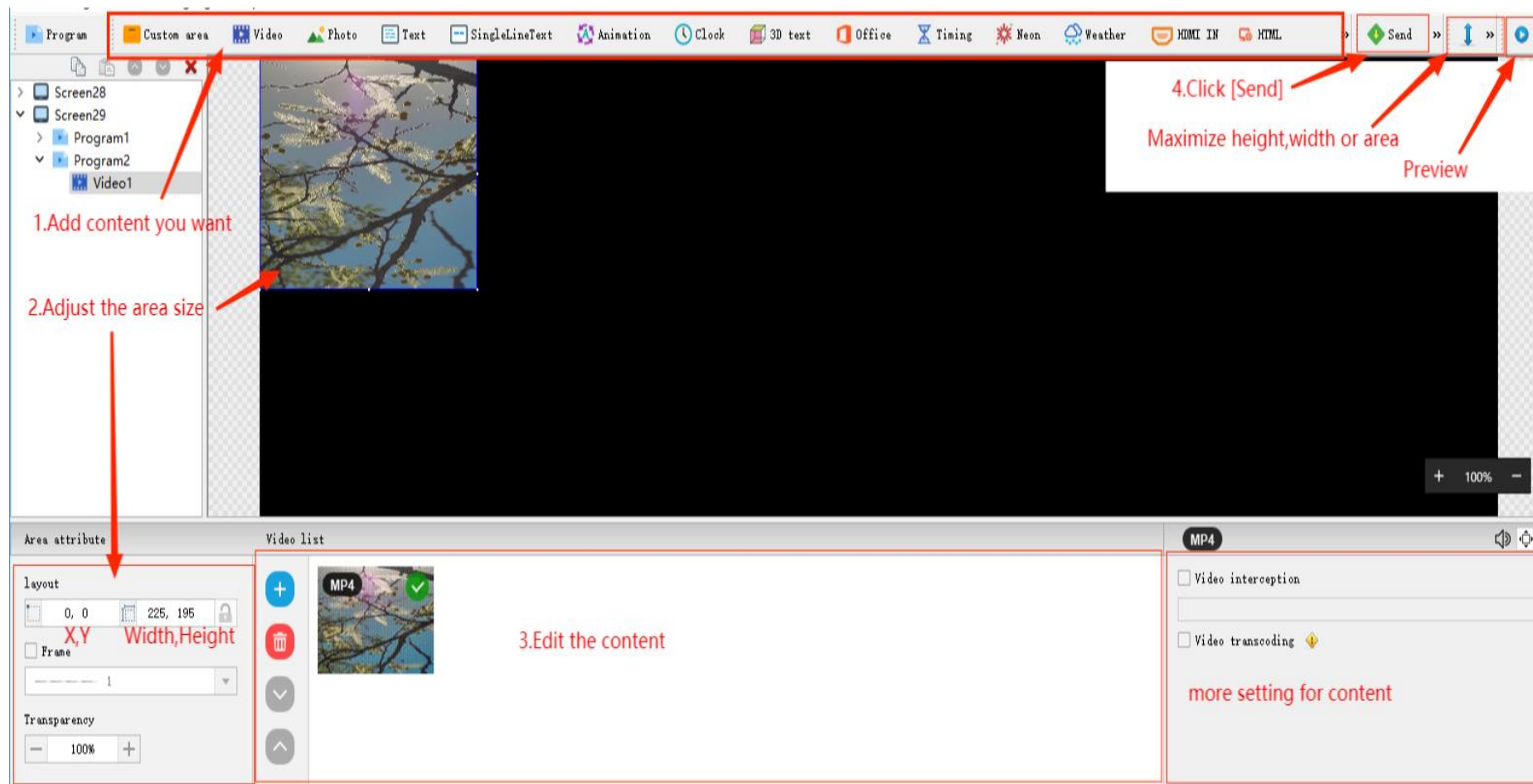

4.1 Publish programs by HDPlayer

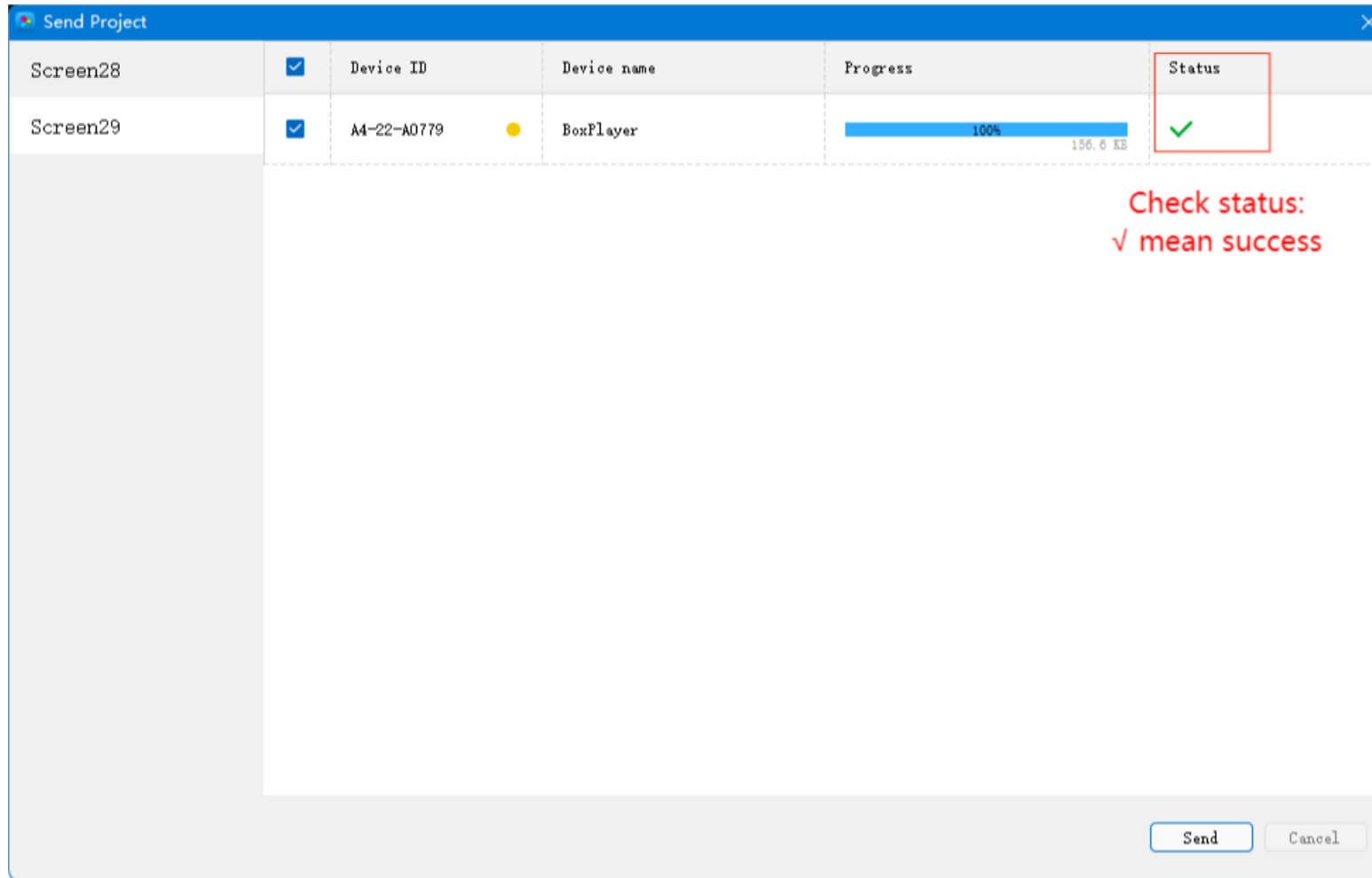
1. Create new program



2.Add content into Program



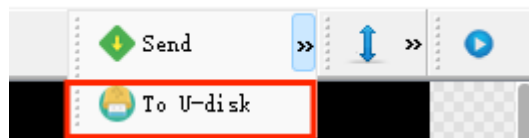
3. Sending interface
